AGREEMENT OF SERVICES

- SEG Student-Athlete Advisory Service (SAAS) is NOT a recruiting or scouting service. Our program is designed to reduce the wide information gap between colleges, admissions offices, athletic programs and the student-athlete. In consideration for the payment of the fees associated with the SSAAS program chosen, we agree to provide the services outlined in such program's materials and attached hereto. Our provision of services is strictly limited to those outlined in the attached materials.
- SAAS is NOT a college placement program. We neither guarantee admissions to the college of your choice nor a roster spot in a preferred sports program.

For Sophomore, Junior and Senior programs we will:

- provide an honest evaluation of the student-athlete's abilities and performance while giving sound advice and support throughout the recruiting process.
- guide the student-athlete through the application process, providing advice on how to go about writing resumes, application essays and similar materials. We will NOT write resumes/essays for the student-athlete.
- assign the student-athlete to a SAAS advisor who has appropriate expertise.
- provide ongoing advising based on the student-athlete's college preferences, priorities, overall academic standing and athletic ability/accomplishments.
- give the student-athlete ownership over the process, advising her on how to be proactive and efficient with regard to marketing herself to college coaches. The SAAS staff will assist the student-athlete during this process. An SAAS Advisor *may* have contact with a college coach where various players are discussed, but this is not a guaranteed, inherent or fee-based aspect of the SAAS and should not be expected.
- provide the student-athlete with college preparation materials, motivational literature, and materials outlining the importance of proper physical training and the mental aspect of field hockey.

Additional Provisions for Sophomore, Junior and Senior Packages

- Student-athletes **MUST** apply to be accepted into the SAAS. SAAS staff reserves the right to refuse entry into the program if we feel the student-athlete does not have the ability to compete in intercollegiate athletics, does not reach his full potential in the classroom, or is not motivated enough to take a proactive approach to his college search. The SAAS Director will review each candidate for admission on a case-by-case basis and will consider all relevant information before making a final decision.
- The Basic SAAS Package will include an Initial Meeting/Consultation with up to 2 hours of follow-up consultation including the development of a plan of attack.
- SAAS staff **WILL** offer (for an additional charge) optional components to the SAAS. These optional components include the Personal Coach and Trainer Package (PCTP), Private Lessons, Skills Videotaping Sessions and Highlight Videos.
- Once Agreement of Services is signed, SEG will not give refunds for the SAAS or any of its components.
- SAAS provides numerous documents during the process. To the extent there are any inconsistencies between this Agreement of Services and any other document provided by SAAS, this Agreement of Services shall prevail.
